Our courses

Something for everyone, including you...

IH Barcelona offers a wide range of Spanish courses designed to cater for a wide variety of needs and interests. The following list is a selection of our most popular courses. If you don't find what you're looking for here, that doesn't mean we can't help you.



1. Intensive Group Courses

which is taken by 90% of our adult students. It consists of 20 hours tuition per week with classes normally held from 09.30-13.30, Monday to Friday.

We offer ten levels of study which range from absolute beginners to very advanced. Students with some knowledge of Spanish can start any Monday throughout the year (except public holidays). Courses for complete beginners start on alternate Mondays.



2. Intensive Plus Courses

Designed for students who want to study more then 20 hours week, these courses combine an Intensive Group Course with afternoons. The afternoon sessions. which run from 14.30 to 16.00. Tuesday to Friday, are designed to give students the opportunity to develop their speaking and comprehension skills by talking about various aspects of Spanish culture and history. Some afternoon sessions may take place outside the school.

Minimum Level: Lower Intermediate



3. DELE Preparation Courses

The "Instituto Cervantes" organises exams in the Spanish language known as "Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera" (or DELE) examinations. The exams are offered at three levels: "Inicial", "Intermedio" and "Superior".

IH Barcelona offers courses designed to prepare students for these DELE exams. Each course lasts for 4 weeks and includes 20 hours of tuition per week.

The minimum level required to take the DELE Preparation course is Lower Intermediate. If you're not sure of your level, try our free on-line level test which you'll find on our website.

Minimum Level: Lower Intermediate

4. Business Spanish Courses

This is our 'standard' Spanish course The aim of the courses is to help improve the students' level of competency in a range of work related activities such as participating in meetings, using the telephone for business, negotiating and selling, making presentations, etc. Students are also introduced to a wide range of business vocabulary and given an insight into the sort of cultural differences that they may come across while working or doing business in a Spanish speaking country.

> Business Spanish courses consist of 4 or 6 hours tuition per day for 2 weeks making 40 or 60 hours in total. Students who take the 60 hour course can take an exam at the end of the course, organised by the Madrid Chamber of Commerce.

Minimum Level: Intermediate

5. Summer course for Teenagers in Tarragona (13-17)

Tarragona is an ideal location for teenagers. Situated on the Costa Dorada (Gold Coast) approximately 100 km south of Barcelona, Tarragona is lively, but not too big; it has its own sandy beaches within walking distance of the school; it is very close to Port Aventura one of Europe's largest theme parks and it is only an hour from Barcelona.

The course includes:

- Airport transfer service on arrival and departure
- 3 hours of Spanish classes per day in multinational groups
- All teaching materials, tests and certificates
- Accommodation on a full board basis with a Spanish host family or in the student residence
- A full and varied programme of sports and other activities including local visits and excursions
- Basic medical insurance

6. Courses for the Over 50s

These 2-week courses are designed for students over the age of 50 who prefer to study and socialise with people of their own age. The course consists of 3 hours a day of Spanish classes, which take place from 10.00 to 13.00, Monday to Friday. The course also includes a special programme of visits to places of interest inside the city, a lunch or dinner in a typical Barcelona restaurant, and an excursion outside Barcelona at the weekend.

7. Individual Tuition

Students can take from 1 to 6 hours of individual tuition per day. Students can either study entirely in this way, or, if they prefer, combine an Intensive Group Course in the mornings with 1, 2 or more hours of individual tuition in the afternoons.

The contents, times and starting dates of these private classes can be arranged to suit the individual student's needs.

We can also offer similarly tailor-made classes for two students studying together providing they have similar levels and linguistic needs.

8. The Executive Plus Course

This is a 5-day super-intensive Spanish language course designed for people who need to make a lot of progress in a very short space of time.

Each course includes:

- 30 hours of one-to-one tuition
- Working lunch with teachers every day.
- Guided individual project work.
- Use of up-to-date, authentic study
- Visits to Spanish companies (arranged on request).
- Two dinners during the course with
- Optional evening cultural programme (to be arranged by agreement).

Executive Plus courses can start any Monday throughout the year.



9. Spanish Internships

This programme combines a 4-week (or more) Intensive Spanish course with a 12-week (or more) work experience programme in a company based in or near Barcelona. The work experience component is designed to help students learn job-related skills while practising their Spanish. Work experience is considered to be a training programme and students are therefore not paid for their time.

Students interested in following an Internship programme should apply at least 3 months in advance of their preferred starting date. This will provide us with plenty of time to find a suitable company prepared to offer the work experience component. Students should indicate on their application form which sector or industry they are interested in working in (e.g. tourism, shipping, insurance, architecture, horticulture, etc.). We will then do our best to find a position in a company working in each student's preferred field.

All students applying for an internship should send us a copy of their CV, together with a recent photo.

Please note that because of certain legal restrictions, this programme is only open to full-time students from the European Union.

Minimum Level: Intermediate

10. Spanish at Work

This programme offers students the opportunity to develop their Spanish while being paid to work in the tourist sector. Students first take an Intensive Group Course at the school for a minimum of 6 weeks. During this time we will organise job interviews with local companies through local employment agencies. Students studying with us for 6-12 weeks have to pay a work placement fee. Students studying with us for more than 12 weeks are not charged for the work placement.

Following their course, students who are offered employment may then work for 2-6 months in a hotel, bar or restaurant. Pay and conditions of employment vary from company to company.

Please note that because of certain legal restrictions, this programme is only open to citizens of the European Union.

Minimum Level: Lower Intermediate

11. On-line Spanish Courses

IH Barcelona is the birthplace of Net Languages - one of the world's leading virtual language schools. Net Languages offers a range of Web-based language courses including Spanish courses for adults (16 or over).

Each course (or level) consists of 120-150 hours of study materials and includes individual tutorials with qualified language instructors, most of whom are themselves IH teachers. Students who buy a course are also given access to all the resources of our virtual language school (the library, study centre, café, etc.) and through the school they also have access to our growing community of language learners around the world.

12. Intensive Group Courses in different cities

IH Barcelona offers students the possibility of combining their studies in Barcelona with a similar course in a different part of the country. In other words, students can now take a course in Barcelona of 2, 3, 4 or more weeks and then continue their studies in Palma, Madrid, San Sebastian, Sevilla or one of a number of other IH schools in Spain.

13. Custom-designed Courses for Special, Closed Groups

IH Barcelona can design and give "madeto-measure" courses at any time of the year for any kind of group. We will be pleased to send you a quotation for any specific course programme you would like us to design for you.

14. Extensive Group Courses

Our Extensive Group Courses are designed for people who are living and/or working in Barcelona and don't have the time available to study intensively. These courses consist of 4 hours of class per week with each course lasting 10 weeks (a term). We offer these extensive group courses at all levels from beginners to very advanced. We also offer a number of specialist courses on an extensive basis such as DELE Preparation Courses, Spanish for Business, etc.*

15. Spanish Teacher Training Courses

IH Barcelona has been training teachers of Spanish since 1986 and we currently train around 250 Spanish language teachers per year. We offer three basic course programmes:

- Introductory Courses for people with little or no previous teaching experience
- Advanced Course for experienced teachers
- Methodology and Culture Courses for non-native teachers of Spanish

IH Barcelona can also provide tailor-made teacher training courses to suit the needs and requirements of any particular group of teachers.

1. Host families

All our host families have been carefully selected by our accommodation department and many of them have been working with us for years. Students are always accommodated in single rooms (unless a couple request to share) and they can choose between Bed and Breakfast or Half Board (which includes dinner in the evening).

2. Executive host families

Some of our families can offer students a number of extra services such as their own private bathroom, as well as a laundry and ironing service. These 'executive families' also offer both bed and breakfast and half board.

3. Rooms in shared apartments

IH Barcelona can offer students a single or double room in a fully furnished apartment which they share with other students. Meals are not included but the fee does include a weekly cleaning service as well as the use of linen and

4. Private apartments

IH Barcelona also offers students the option of renting their own private apartment for their own exclusive use. Prices vary according to the size of the apartment.

5. Student residences

In July, August and September,* IH Barcelona is able to offer students accommodation in one of the city's university residences. Students can choose

single or shared rooms with bed and breakfast or half board.

* Please note that a limited number of rooms in student residences are available throughout the year. Please contact our Spanish department for details on availability.

6. Hotels and hostels

As one of the world's leading tourist destinations Barcelona has a huge number of hotels and hostels to choose from, many of which are less than a 10minute walk from the school. IH Barcelona is happy to provide students with prices and help make reservations.

GENERAL NOTES

All our accommodation is normally reserved from the Sunday preceding the course until the Saturday after the course ends. If needed extra nights can usually be arranged on request.

While some accommodation is within walking distance of the school, other accommodation may be 20-25 minutes away by public transport. Our aim is always to provide the highest standard of accommodation for our students, irrespective of distance from the school.
